



Diagnosis Codes

Go to Add/Edit Data and select Diagnosis Codes.




This will bring up a list of all available diagnosis codes for use in the software.



You can sort by code or Description by clicking on the column header.

Adding a code: First, check to make sure it is valid by going to the web site <https://www.icd10data.com/> . If it is valid, go to the ADD button and a box will appear where you can enter your new code with the description.





When you hit Save, your code will appear on the Diagnosis Codes master list.




You can edit a code description by highlighting the code you would like to alter and selecting the Edit button on the right.




If the code has been confirmed as invalid on the ICD10 website, you can delete it. The code will no longer appear on the list.

NOTE: This will NOT remove the code from anyone who has it in funding.

Highlight the code you want to eliminate and click on Delete on the right.




A box will appear asking if you are sure that you want to delete that specific code:



If you click Yes, the code will no longer be in the list, and you will no longer be able to use that code on any claim moving forward.
